- Half-bridge/full-bridge switched-mode power supplies




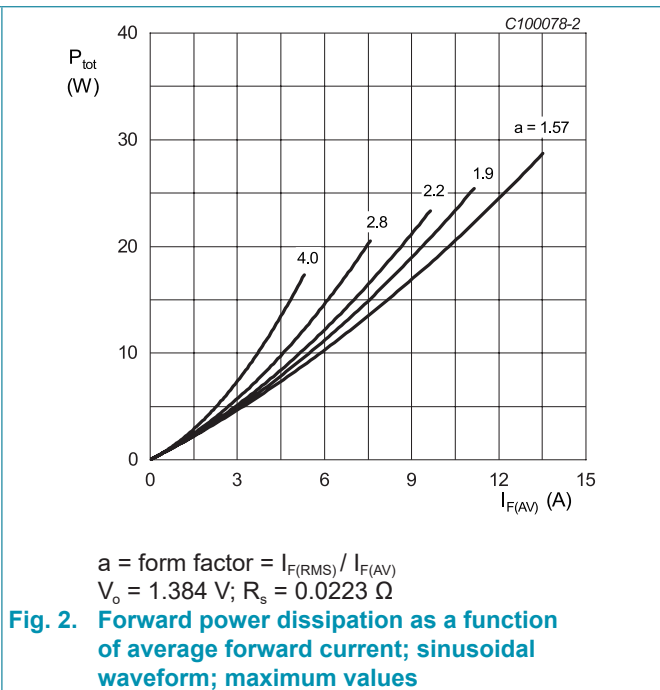
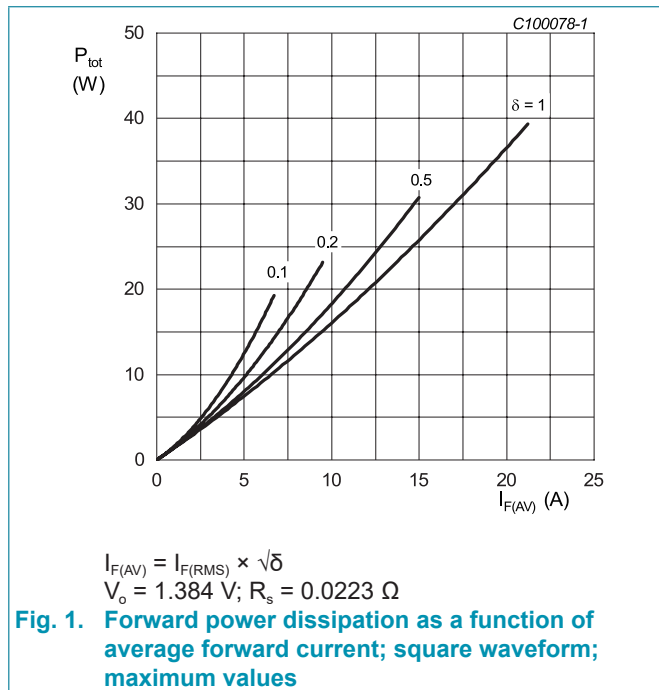

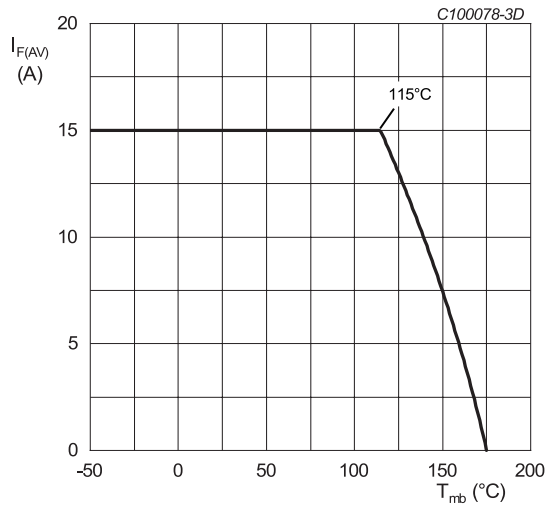


Fig. 3. Forward current as a function of mounting base temperature; maximum values

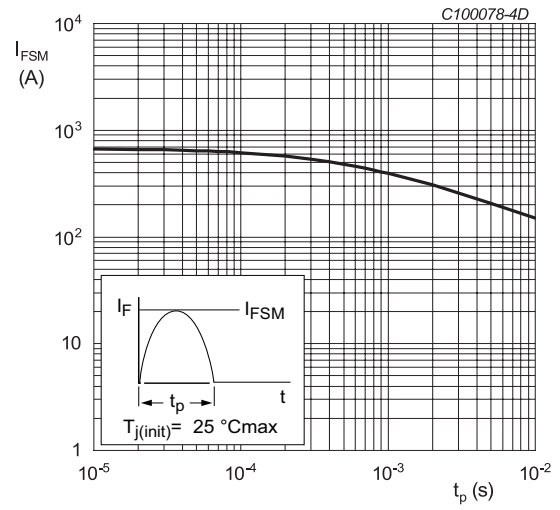


Fig. 4. Non-repetitive peak forward current as a function of pulse width; sinusoidal waveform; maximum values

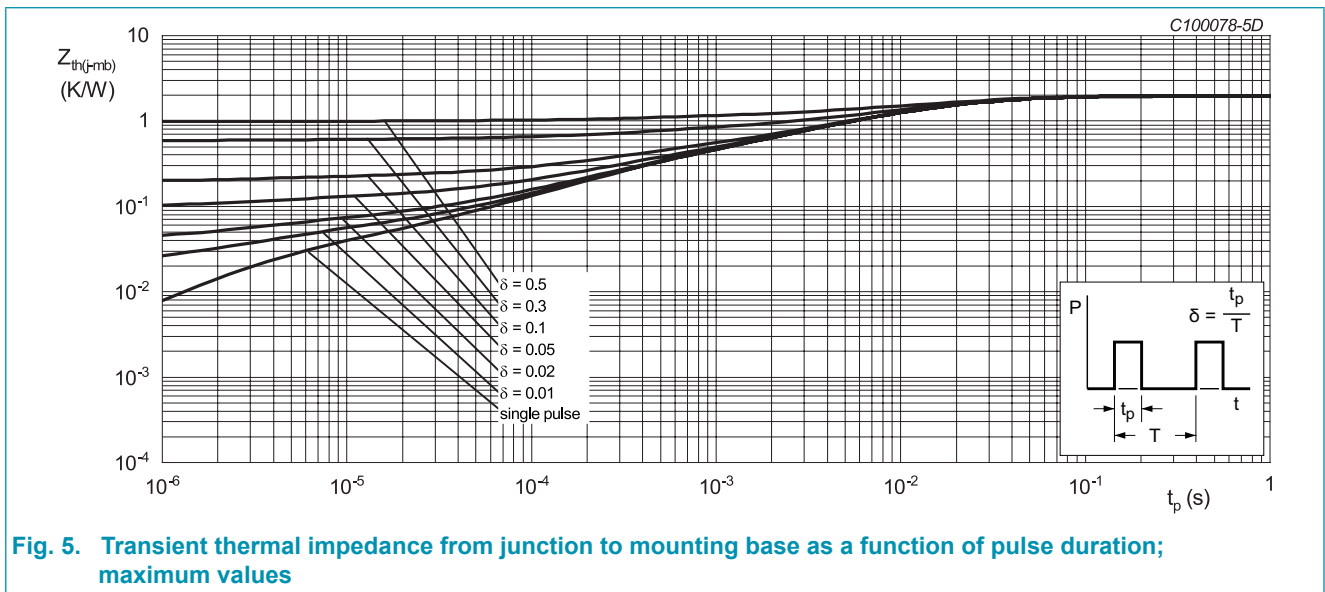
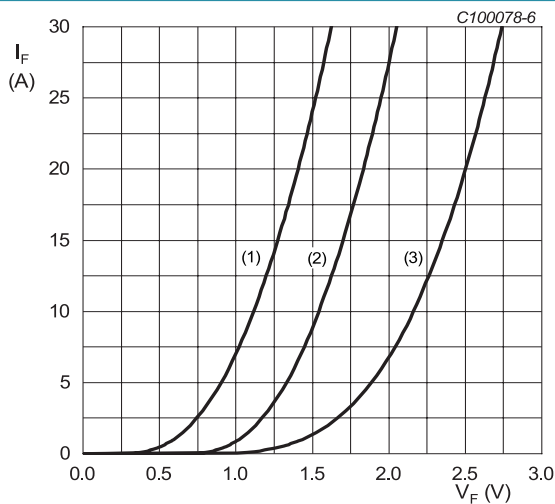


Fig. 5. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse duration; maximum values

Fig. 6. Forward current as a function of forward voltage

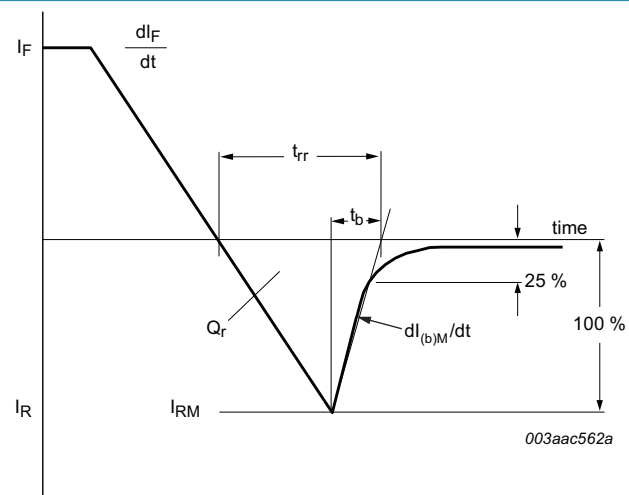
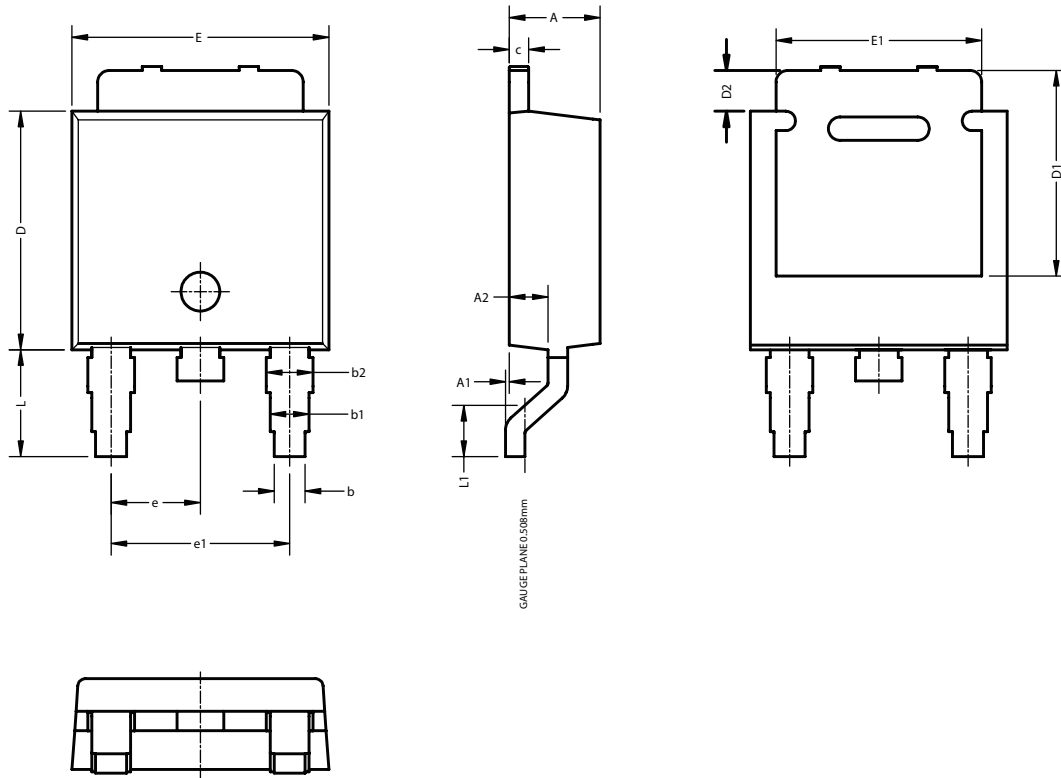


Fig. 7. Reverse recovery definitions; ramp recovery
